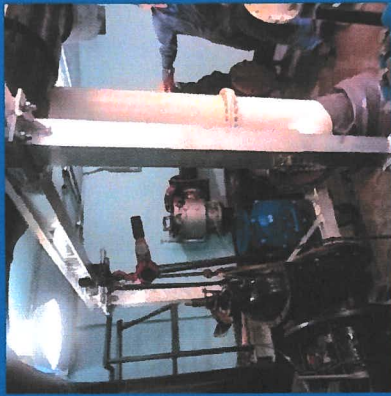


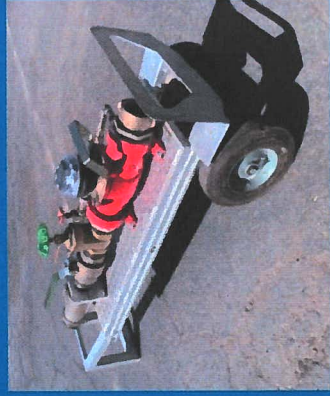

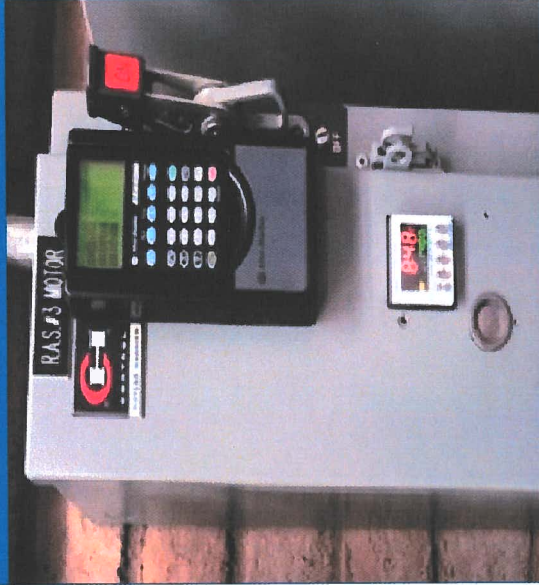

Safety Awards Program

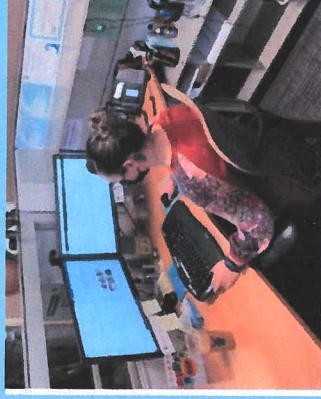
The H.R. LaBounty Safety Awards Program recognizes ACWA JPIA water industry employees who implement significant safety improvements to prevent occupational injuries/illness. The Program is designed for all JPIA members to promote safe workplace behavior and operations practices, while rewarding those employees who demonstrate safe behavior, take part in recognizable proactive activities, or participate in risk-reducing actions. It gives members another way to foster a safety culture that reduces the potential for losses.

Examples of nominations that would NOT qualify for the H.R. LaBounty Safety Award

- Incentives for programs that may discourage workers from reporting occupational injuries.
- Nominations related to "conditions of employment", e.g., wearing or providing required PPE, or providing Safety Data Sheets.
- Equipment modifications performed without manufacturer approval and may affect the warranty.
- Equipment fabricated in-house where a readily available commercial product that meets regulatory requirements is available.
- Nominations for written safety programs, policies, and procedures to meet basic regulatory requirements, e.g., IIPP.

Examples of Qualified Nominations

- New methods/equipment with process improvements to reduce manual material handling.
- Conduct ergonomic evaluations after completion of The Back School CEAS program or comparable program.



Ergonomic Improvements

- Participate in an annual review of the Injury and Illness Prevention Program, including a recommended action plan for improvements.
- Create Job Safety Analysis (JSA) and deliver training on specific operations.
- Near-miss events that resulted in the implementation of corrective actions.
- Participate in the annual review of confined space entry permits resulting in corrective actions to improve the program.

- Develop a Standard Operation Procedure (SOP) and deliver training on a specific operation.



Fall Protection Open Hatches

- Identify procedures to eliminate the need to enter a confined space.
- Participate in the review of a project specific contractor safety program.
- Participate in the hazard inspection program and develop and implement corrective actions.
